Actaea pachypoda-White baneberry (shade)

Allium cernuum -Nodding Onion (sun to part shade)

Aquilegia canadensis-Wild Columbine (partial shade)

Arctostaphylos uva- ursi -Common Bearberry (sun to part shade)

Asclepias incarnata -Swamp milkweed (sun)

Asclepias purpurascens-Purple milkweed (sun)

Asclepias syriaca -Common Milkweed- sun

Asclepias tuberosa -Butterfly Weed (sun)

Aster-novae-angliae - new name is Symphyotrichum  
New England Aster- sun part shade

Baptisia australis-Blue False Indigo (sun to part shade)

Caltha palustris -Marsh marigold (sun to part shade)

Chelone glabra -White turtlehead (sun to part shade)

Chelone lyonii -Turtlehead (sun to part shade)

Cimicifuga racemose (aka Actaea) -Bugbane or Black Cohosh (shade to part shade)

Cornus canadensis -Bunchberry (part shade)

Dodecatheon meadia -Shooting Star (part shade)

Echinacea pallida -Pale purple coneflower (full sun to part shade)

Echinacea paradoxa -Yellow coneflower (full sun)

Conoclinium coelestinum (aka Eupatorium) -Blue mist flower (sun to part shade)

Eupatorium perfoliatum- White Boneset (sun to part shade)

*Gentiana clausa* -Bottle Gentian (sun to part shade)

*Lobelia cardinalis* -Cardinal flower (sun to part shade)

*Monarda fistulosa* -Wild Bergamot (sun to part shade)

*Aristolochia macrophylla*- Dutchman's pipe (sun to part shade)

*Pycnanthemum muticum* -Blunt mountainmint (sun to part shade)

*Pycnanthemum tenuifolium* -Mountain Mint (sun to part shade)

*Echinacea paradoxa*- Bush's Coneflower (sun)

*Rudbeckia laciniata*- Green-headed Coneflower- (sun to part shade)

*Verbena hastata*- Blue vervain (sun)

*Salix discolor*- Pussywillow (sun to part shade)

*Vernonia noveboracensis*- Ironweed (sun)

*Veronicastrum* Lavendelturm'-Culver's Root 'Lavender Towers' (sun)

*Veronicastrum virginicum*-Culver's Root (sun)

*Viola sororia* 'Freckles'- Meadow violet (sun to part shade)

*Zizia aptera*-Heart- leaved Golden Alexanders (sun to part shade)
